
BRABANTIA PORTABLE BLENDER

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using this appliance, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including but not limited to the following:

- 1. Read all instructions prior to using the appliance.
- 2. Use only a power supply corresponding to the marking on the bottom of the motor base.
- 3. ALWAYS exercise care when handling the blade assembly as the blades are sharp. Failure to use care when handling the blade assembly may result in a risk of laceration.
- 4. Take your time and exercise care during unpacking and appliance setup. This appliance contains sharp, loose blades that may cause injury if mishandled.
- 5. Before use, wash all parts that contact food. Follow the cleaning instructions in this instruction manual.
- 6. DO NOT blend hot liquids, effervescent, or carbonated liquids, as doing so may cause pressure buildup, resulting in risk of burns or other injuries to the user.
- 7. DO NOT fill the blending cup past the 400ml mark, exceeding this line can result in leakage or stoppage of the blade.
- 8. DO NOT overfill the cup body with ice as it may stop the blades from turning resulting in damage to the unit or injury.
- 9. DO NOT put your hands inside the cup body or anywhere near the blade assembly. Keep hair, and clothing out of the cup body when loading and operating as blades can still activate when the sip lid is removed.
- 10. ALWAYS ensure the cup body is securely locked on the motor base before blending. This model will not turn on unless the cup body is secure.
- 11. Remove utensils prior to processing. Failure to remove utensils may cause damage to the blending cup, or personal injury.
- 12. DO NOT submerge the motor base in any form of liquid to
- DO NOT store outdoors.
- 14. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used near children. DO NOT allow children to use as a toy.
- 15. This appliance is NOT intended to be used by people with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- 16. DO NOT use if the blade is bent or damage is suspected. Before each use, inspect the blade assembly for damage.
- 17. DO NOT attempt to sharpen blades.
- DO NOT allow any part of the unit to contact hot surfaces, including stoves and other heating appliances.
- 19. ALWAYS use the appliance on a dry and level surface.





- 20. ONLY use attachments and accessories that are provided with the product. The use of attachments not approved for this appliance may cause fire, electric shock, or injury and may void the warranty.
- 21. Avoid contact with moving parts during operation and handling of the appliance.
- 22. DO NOT operate the appliance with an empty cup body.
- 23. DO NOT microwave any containers or accessories provided with the appliance.
- 24. Blend soft fruit/vegetables and liquids only. DO NOT use the appliances for grinding meat, beans, nuts or very hard ingredients, this will cause product failure and affect product life.
- 25. DO NOT expose the containers and accessories to extreme temperature changes as this may cause damage.
- 26. NEVER leave the appliance unattended while in use.
- If you find unmixed ingredients sticking to the sides of the cup body, turn the
 appliance off using the power button, and use a scraper to dislodge ingredients.
- 28. DO NOT attempt to remove the cup body and/or sip lid from the motor base while the blade is still spinning. Allow the appliance to come to a complete stop before removing lid and/or cup body.
- 29. DO NOT store ingredients for extended amounts of time before or after blending them. Some foods may contain active ingredients or release gases that will expand if left in a sealed container. This may result in excessive pressure buildup that can pose a risk of injury.
- 30. Should the appliance overheat, a thermal switch will activate and temporarily disable the motor. To reset, turn OFF the appliance using the power button and allow it to cool for approximately 15 minutes before using again.
- 31. DO NOT idle the appliance, stop the machine after idling for 5 seconds and restart.
- 32. The appliance will operate for a maximum of 20 seconds before the motor automatically stops.
- 33. DO NOT process dry ingredients without adding liquid to the cup body. This appliance is not intended for dry blending.
- 34. Only operate with the sip lid on.
- 35. DO NOT refrigerate or freeze the appliance.
- 36. Switch off the appliance before changing accessories.
- 37. DO NOT misuse the appliance as it may cause injury.

BATTERY USE

The battery is the power source for the Brabantia Portable Blender. Carefully read and follow the instructions.


- DO NOT incinerate this appliance even if it is severely damaged. The lithium ion batteries Always properly recycle products powered by lithium-ion batteries.
- Prevent accidental blade activation by ensuring the blender is turned OFF when not in use, while cleaning, or when drinking from the sip lid.
- Keep the battery away from all metal objects such as paper clips, coins, keys, nails, or



screws. Shorting the battery terminals together increases the risk of fire or burns.

- A DC motor and battery are inside the appliance.
- A USB-C charger is included with this appliance.
- The appliance includes a minimum charge after production. Please fully charge it before your first use, using the USB-C provided. The charging port is located at the front of the motor base under the ON/OFF button.
- The minimum charging time is 4 hours, the maximum is 5 hours. DO NOT overcharge or leave the appliance to charge overnight. This will shorten the life of the appliance and battery.
- This appliance contains lithium-ion batteries that are not replaceable

USING YOUR PORTABLE BLENDER

Remove all packaging materials from the appliance.

Before use: hand wash the cup body and lid with hot, soapy water. You can also clean the cup body by adding cold water and a drop of dishwashing soap to the cup body and blending for one cycle.

Rinse clean and dry.

Gently rinse the blade assembly and wipe with a damp sponge or cloth. NEVER submerge or run the motor base under water.

DO NOT put any parts of this appliance in the dishwasher.

Always store this appliance in a safe place, upright with the cup body attached, so that the blades are covered and not exposed.

IMPORTANT: ENSURE YOU READ THE INSTRUCTION MANUAL BEFORE PROCEEDING.

- 1. Ensure the motor base is fully charged and the cup is properly installed by aligning the cup body with the motor base.
- 2. Add ingredients, starting with solid ingredients cut into small pieces (approx. 1.5cm x 1.5cm) then liquid ingredients to the 400ml line. If using ice, always add after the solid and liquid ingredients. DO NOT fill ingredients (including ice) past the 400ml line.
- 3. Secure lid onto the cup, twisting clockwise to tighten. Make sure the lid latch is upright and in the locked position.
- 4. Press the ON/OFF button to blend for a 20-second blend cycle. If you need to pulse the ingredients or stop you blend cycle early, simply press the ON/OFF button again to stop.
- 5. The digital LED will indicate the number of seconds of blending.
- 6. Unlock the lid latch by pulling down the latch and push up the lid to open and reveal the spout.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- STEP 1: Always make sure the appliance is turned OFF and the charger is NOT connected to the charging port after each use.
- STEP 2: Hand-wash the Cup and Lid with warm, soapy water and rinse clean. NOTE: None of the parts of this appliance are dishwasher safe.
- STEP 3: Gently rinse the blade assembly and wipe with a damp sponge or cloth. NOTE: The motor base must not be submerged in water.

You can also clean the cup body by adding cold water and a drop of dishwashing soap to the cup body and blending for one cycle.

WARNING: Do not touch blades! They are very sharp.

WARNING: Do not blend hot or warm liquids.

WARNING: Never submerge the Motor Base into water or any other liquid.



TROUBLESHOOTING

| PROBLEM | REASON | HOW TO SOLVE |
|--|--|---|
| Portable Blender not working | The cup body is not screwed onto the motor base securely | Tighten the cup body onto the motor base |
| Portable Blender stops working and LED display shows LO | Battery power is low | Charge the portable blender |
| Portable Blender stops working and LED display shows 5 seconds | Blender has been run idle for 5 seconds or more, the appliance automatically stops | Press the ON/OFF button to restart |
| Portable Blender stops working and LED display flashes ER slowly | Blades and motor are locked due to hard object | Remove the hard object and restart |
| LED display flashes ER fast when securing the cup body | The motor is locked due to cup body not tightly secured | Resecure the cup body onto the motor base tightly |
| Portable Blender is leaking | The silicone ring is not inserted correctly | Insert the silicone ring correctly |
| LED display flashes CH | The appliance is charging | This is normal operation when charging |
| LED display shows FU | The appliance is fully charged | This is normal operation when fully charged |
